Please read the following medications policy and sign. On the reverse side fill out your child's medical history and return the first day of school in September. Have a great summer!

MEDICATION GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES:

School nurses are not permitted to dispense medication without a doctor's written permission. A doctor may prescribe medication that can be given to a student during school hours. Only those medications that meet the student's health needs for specific period of time may be given during school day.

GUIDELINES FOR ADMINISTERING MEDICATIONS IN SCHOOL

Only written orders from doctors are acceptable. They should include beginning date, discontinuation dates, and diagnosis of the disease medication is for. If the medication is to be given on a continuing basis, a doctor's note must be provided at the beginning of each school year. A written note from parents/guardians also is required when any medication is to be given by the nurse.

All medication must be in pharmacy labeled containers with the student's name, medicine identification, dosage, time to be given and dates. The doctor's and pharmacy's telephone numbers are needed in case there are unanticipated side effects.

All NON-PRESCRIPATION DRUGS ARE TO BE HANDLES IN THE SAME MANNER AS PRESCRIBED DRUGS. Therefore, the nurse will administer drugs such as Aspirin, Tylenol. Antihistamines, or Non-prescription cough syrup only upon receipt of written notes from the Doctor and parent/guardian. A labeled bottle of the over-the-counter medication also must be provided.

Parents/ Guardians should bring the medication to the school office (give to the secretary/nurse) along with notes from the doctor and themselves.

Please remember all students entering 6th grade born after 1/1/1997 and reaching age 11 must have Tdap shot and Meningococcal shot. Forms were provided to you a few weeks back. Proof of these shots must be submitted by Sept. 1st.

To: All Sixth Grade Parents

From: School Nurse

AS of Sept.1st,2008 all students entering 6th grade are required To have new immunization requirement. The law as follows

8:57-4.10 Diphtheria and Tetanus toxiods and Pertussis vaccine (h) Every child born on or after January 1, 1997, and entering or attending Grade Six, or a comparable age level special education program with an unassigned grade on or after September 1, 2008, shall have received one dose of Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis) given no earlier than the 10th birthday. (i) children entering or attending Grade Six on or after September 1, 2008, who received a Td booster dose less than five years prior to entry or attendance shall not be required to receive a Tdap dose until five years have elapsed from the last DTP/DTaP or Td dose.

8:57-4.20 Meningococcal vaccine

(a) Every child born on or after January 1st 1997, and entering or attending Grade Six Or a comparable age level special education program with an unassigned grade on or September 1st, 2008, shall have received one dose of a meningococcal-containing vaccine, such as the medically-preferred meningococcal conjugate vaccine.

*Please note: This applies to students when they turn 11 years of age and attending Grade Six


