Contractor heavy duty 3 mil thick trash bags

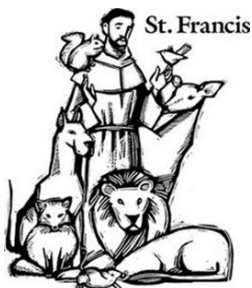
paper towels
