3/21- Assembly R.A.P.- Realize Anything is Possible (Grades K-8)

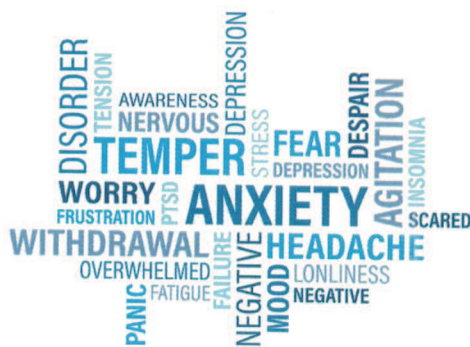
3/26- Field Trip Grades 5-8

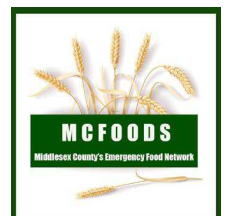
To Benefit MCFOODS:

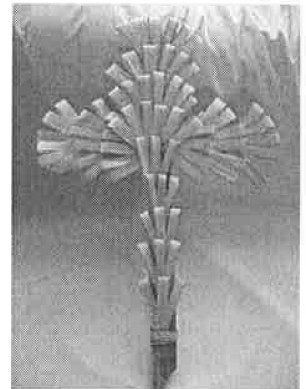
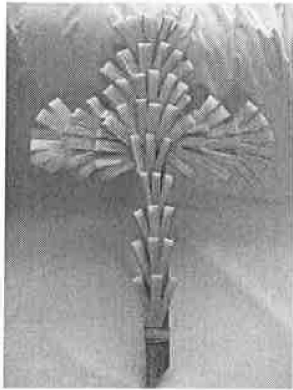
