The following are some quick bits of information you will find helpful for starting off the school year.

1. Friday, September 7, 2018: all summer work is due to the appropriate teacher, this is graded work that will be reflected in the first marking period's grades. There are no exceptions to the due date.
2. **All school closings, delayed openings and other important information will be relayed ONLY** through our Honeywell Alert system. Please be sure to register your family no later than September 10th. Directions on how to do so were sent home previously; if you need help please contact the office.
3. Our Back to School Night will be September 11th. Our book fair will begin September 10th and run through September 13th.
4. There will be two security/fire drills each month. These drills are required by law and prepare faculty and students in case of an unlikely emergency. You will receive a quick note home after each of these drills so you are aware they took place.
6. We will be hosting a high school fair on September 14th during school hours, for our 7th and 8th grade students.
7. September 26th will be an early dismissal to accommodate Sayreville schools half day schedule. This will avoid busing issues that day.
8. Before and aftercare has begun. The application/information sheet can be found on our website. All students must have one completed before they can be admitted to before or aftercare.
9. Thank you for entrusting St. Stan's with your most precious possession, your child; it is a privilege being part of their education.
