Imagine our young students coming to grips with this idea. We will be continuing our Social and Emotional Learning Backpack lessons this year in kindergarten through eighth grade. These class periods allow us to focus on subjects that our students need to be competent in to tackle the world they live in.

We have received a letter from the borough engineer in Sayreville, explaining the work that will be taking place on our street (MacArthur Avenue). This major project is starting on the Washington Road end of MacArthur Avenue and working its way towards Main Street. They will do there best to keep a single lane open on MacArthur Avenue at all times; regardless of this we anticipate traffic to be a concern at times. Please be sure you allow extra time if you drop off or pick up your child, to deal with any delays you may encounter.

On September 27<sup>th</sup> we look forward to our Color Run Fundraiser. Please refer to last week's letter in reference to what children should wear and how the color may stain their clothes. If your child is staying for after care on the 27th, please send your child in with a change of clothes and a plastic bag to place their color run clothes in; also please note Friday, September 27<sup>th</sup> is an early dismissal day.

In the coming weeks, we will begin our M.A.P. testing; I will send information home next week on what this will entail. Also, October 2<sup>nd</sup> grades PreK through third will have a fire safety assembly and on October 4<sup>th</sup> the school will celebrate our first school Mass at 9am. I hope you will be able to join us. As always, my door is open to you should you have any questions or concerns.
