ACTION ALERT

Nonpublic School Nursing Services and School Transportation

ISSUE:

The accounts for nonpublic school nursing services and transportation continue to be underfunded. The funding for nursing services has not kept up with the additional legislative requirements that a school nurse must perform, including the administration of certain medications and their role as first responder in a school emergency.

Nonpublic school transportation continues to be problematic for many students, with the result being that parents receive aid-in-lieu payments instead of transportation. Aid-in-lieu for parents at the current rate does not help in getting their children to and from a nonpublic school from which they may be forced to transfer.

OUR

POSITION: The New Jersey Catholic Conference and the Catholic school community support an increase in Nonpublic School Nursing Services to \$150.00 per pupil to cover the increased cost of nurses' salaries and the cost of other requirements imposed by the Legislature. They also support the raising of the per-pupil statutory ceiling for nonpublic school transportation to \$1,300 per pupil in order to have bus routes run for the majority of our students.

ACTION:

Call, write or email the Office of Governor Phil Murphy and ask for the requested increases in nursing services to \$150.00 per pupil and to \$1,300 per pupil for transportation. 



Thank you for choosing to give your child(ren) the gift of a Catholic school education, a gift that we realize is given at great sacrifice for many families. For the 2024-2025 school year, we are blessed to provide Diocesan school financial aid to support low-income families who send their children to our elementary and high schools.

To be eligible your child(ren) must be Roman Catholic, must be entering grades K-12 in September 2024, must be registered with your household in one of the parishes within the Diocese of Metuchen (please see the list of eligible parishes on the back of the Application Instructions Form), and must attend one of our 21 diocesan, parochial, or regional elementary schools, or Immaculata High School or St. Thomas Aquinas High School. Students attending the two private high schools in our Diocese (St. Joseph High School and Mount Saint Mary Academy) will need to seek assistance directly from those schools or from Hope through Education (https://hopethrougheducationusa.org).

Families that require computer access and/or help with the online application should contact the school/s where you plan to enroll your child/ren.

Application instructions, with deadlines, are attached and are also available online at diometuchen.org/tuition-assistance. Please note, you are responsible for completing the Parish Verification Form, getting it signed by your Pastor, and returning it to the school or schools where you plan to send your children. If you are enrolling children in more than one school, you should submit a copy of the completed, signed Parish Verification form to the additional school/s.

We are not able to consider an application without this form, signed by you and your Pastor. Please call your parish if you are uncertain about your registration status. If you have application questions, please call FACTS Grant & Aid at 866.315.9262.

Diocese of Metuchen – School Financial Aid 2024-2025 Application Instructions

Families applying for financial aid must complete an online application at https://online.factsmgt.com/aid. The application period opens January 1, 2024 and will officially close on March 31, 2024. Awards will be announced on or about the first week of June 2024.

Online applications are available in Spanish and English. The application fee is \$40 and must be paid online at the time you submit your application. Forms of payment include debit cards, most major credit cards, or an electronic check.

ELIGIBILTY

To be eligible to apply for School Financial Aid:

- Student must be Roman Catholic;
- Student must be entering grades K-12 in September 2024—scholarships are not awarded to children entering Preschool, although they should be included on the FACTS online application;
- Student must be attending one of our 21 diocesan, parochial, or regional elementary schools, or Immaculata or St. Thomas Aquinas High School; and
- Student must be officially registered in one of the parishes within the Diocese of Metuchen, and families must submit a Parish Verification Form to the school/s where they plan to enroll their child/ren by March 31. A copy of the completed, signed Parish Verification form may be used by families enrolling children in more than one school (see list of eligible schools and parishes on page 2 or go to www.diometuchen.org/tuition-assistance to view a list or print the form).
- All families must submit a completed, signed Parish Verification Form to each school their child/ren plan to attend or their FACTS online application will not meet the eligibility requirements for Diocese of Metuchen School Financial Aid and will not be processed.

APPLICATION

Required documents include:

- Copies of your 2022 Federal Income Tax Return Form 1040 (as filed with the IRS) for the applicant and co-applicant, including all supporting tax schedules;
- Copies of all 2023 W2 and/or 1099 forms for both you and your spouse or co-applicant; and
- Copies of documentation for Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Workers' Compensation, and TANF.

Documents must be:

- Scanned or photographed with a Smartphone and uploaded directly to your application.
- FACTS Grant & Aid does not accept documents sent by FAX or Email.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- If you are applying to a Diocese of Metuchen school, your application will automatically "opt in" to the Hope through Education Scholarship Program online application process. If you meet the eligibility requirements for both Programs you will be considered for either Diocesan Financial Aid or a Hope through Education Scholarship

- 3. Tap on the Enter an Event Code card
- 4. Enter the Event Code PCCUPO
- 5. Tap "Create a Pop-up Store"
- 6. Tap "Add Photo" to take or upload a photo
- 7. Set Goal Amount
 - a. This is displayed on your Pop-up Store it won't prevent you from earning more than your goal, but it helps supporters know what you're aiming for!
- 8. Toggle "Feature My Store" <u>DoubleGood.com</u>
 - a. Toggling this on means you are opting to allow your store to be featured on the Double Good website
