AFTERCARE FAMILIES

In preparing for the last few weeks left of school, we are asking families that utilize the aftercare program to pre-pay for the last couple weeks of school (May 31 – June 14). This will help ensure billing is paid for upfront. While we do know that emergencies can come up, if you are a family that doesn't utilize the aftercare program normally, you will be sent home with a bill when you pick up your child. That bill will need to be paid the next day of school.

For families that pre-pay and don't use up all of their payment, you will either be reimbursed for what you didn't use (non-returning families) or have a credit towards the next school year (returning families).

May 1-26 billing invoice will go home with your child on Tuesday, May 31<sup>st</sup> and must be paid in full no later than Friday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Please send in pre-payment to the school office for May 31-June 14 no later than Thursday, May 26<sup>th</sup>. Thank you.


