St. Stanislaus Kostka School will be displaying flags around the school this November to honor those who served and are currently serving our country as members of our military. The flags will also honor our local heroes such as police, firefighters, EMS, and all front line workers.

The cost to sponsor a 3' x 5' flag, which will be displayed on an 8' pole, is \$125.00. Each flag will include an 8.5" x 11" laminated sign that indicates the sponsor or dedication. Each flag will be illuminated after dark by the lighting on our school property or by a solar light.

The proceeds of the Flags for Heroes Fundraiser will be utilized to repair the front sidewalk of the school. From the proceeds, 10% will be donated to the Menlo Park Veterans Memorial Home.


