You will be tested on both of these books when you return to school in September. These tests, the hanging mobile project and the book review will be averaged into your first marking period Language Arts grade.


Remember that both of these books are your responsibility to read by September. The hanging mobile and the book review will be due by Friday, September 5,2014.



Hanging Mobile Project for:

<u>Nate the Great</u>

Materials needed:

- 1 clothes hanger
- 3 pieces of yarn or string of different lengths
- 4 colored index cards
- Card 1: Write the title and author of the book, and your name on the front of one card. You can use markers, crayons or colored pencils for all 4 cards.
- <u>Card 2</u>: List the characters in the story on one side. Draw a picture of your favorite character on the other side.
- Card 3: Write 2 sentences telling what the problem was in the story on one side. On the other side of the card write 2 sentences telling how the problem was solved.
- Card 4: On one side draw a picture of Nate's favorite food. On the other side write what you liked best about the story.
