At this time you will be given your password to our new on-line system, **Power School**, which is very user friendly and will enable you to see your children's grades as soon as they are posted. Mrs. Florczak, our new technology teacher, will give a short presentation that evening explaining how to use the system. You will also learn about **Honeywell**, our new emergency alert system which will be available shortly.

As soon as the main meeting which will be held in the cafeteria is over, parents with children in grades K-5 will meet with their children's teachers in their classrooms. In order to accommodate families having more than one child in the school, these teachers will be holding 2 identical 15 minute presentations about grade work and expectations. The middle school parents will remain in the cafeteria for a joint presentation by the middle school faculty and then may attend the second presentation by the lower grade teachers, if needed.

Please remember that next Monday begins our **Book Fair**. Books will be available for purchase by the students in the main hallway outside the office. Parents are encouraged to browse and purchase books as possible Christmas gifts or to enrich their children's home libraries.




