- 3. December 23rd is a 12 noon dismissal. It is also a dress UP out of uniform day. Students traditionally wear their outfits from the Christmas concert. There will be a 9AM school Mass for which we would love you to join us. The HSA serves students a breakfast after Mass this day and there is a 12 noon dismissal with NO After care.
- 4. We return to school on January 5, 2015.
