

In anticipation of the 2015 Synod of Bishops to be held in Rome this October 4-25, Pope Francis once again has asked Catholic Bishops worldwide for "broad consultation" on addressing contemporary family life issues as well as the Church's role in the lived experience of family life.

The theme of the 2015 Synod is, "The Vocation and Mission of the Family in the Church and Contemporary World." Leaving it up to the local bishops to decide the best way to gather information and contribute to the greater discussion, the Holy See has asked each bishop to use as a guide the final document of the 2014 extraordinary synod as the preparatory document (or *lineamenta*) of the 2015 ordinary synod. The original document includes 46 questions for consideration; the U.S. bishops must submit responses to the USCCB by March 20, 2015.

The Most Rev. Paul Gregory Bootkoski, Bishop of Metuchen, has decided the best way to approach answering this round of questions is to host a "Listening Session on the Lived Experience of Family Life." Offered in English and Spanish, the purpose of the listening session is to identify possible solutions to the various pastoral challenges of the family that were noted in the 2014 extraordinary synod.

All Catholic parishioners who reside in Middlesex, Somerset, Hunterdon and Warren counties are invited and encouraged to attend this interactive forum. See details below.
