Cafeteria Duty



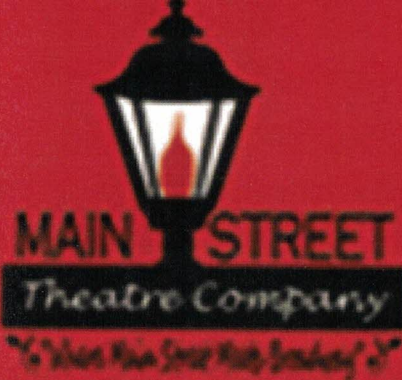
We are in need of volunteers for December
