Dear St. Stan's Families:

That family survey is vital to the school in receiving state and federal funding, it is also entirely confidential. Additionally, in your white envelope you will find a B6T form for transportation and a Textbook form. Again, these forms are imperative in receiving funding. They are due back to school no later than 2/24/17. Please complete both of these forms; even if you have no intention of using a bus or you are unsure if you are re-registration. These forms are our lifeline to funding!

Please be aware that the second marking period ends tomorrow and our quarterly awards ceremony is next Friday, February 3rd during opening exercise. Next Wednesday is a 12 noon dismissal and school is closed February 17th and 20th. Lastly, please mark your calendars for our Texas Road House fundraiser, Wednesday, February 15th. If you show the flyer we sent home or an online post of the flyer, the school will receive 15% of your check.

2017-2018 Foundation for Catholic Education (FCE) Scholarship Application Process

Scholarships will be available through the FCE Scholarship Program for families seeking financial aid for the 2017-2018 school year. This year FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment (FGAA) will again conduct the financial need analysis for our Diocese. Beginning January 30, 2017, applicants can apply online by going to https://online.factsmgt.com/aid.

Online applications are available in Spanish and English. Applications and all required supporting documentation must be submitted to FGAA by March 31, 2017. The application fee is \$30 and must be paid online at the time the family submits their application. Forms of payment include debit cards, most major credit cards, or an electronic check.

Important information about the 2017-2018 program:

- Pastor signature requirements have changed. Parents/Guardians must submit a signed Pastor Signature Form
 (copy attached and available at www.diometuchen.org/tuition-assistance). Parents/Guardians are responsible for
 returning the completed and signed forms to the school/schools their child/ren plan to attend. Families with
 children attending multiple schools may submit a copy of the signed original form to the additional school/s. No
 application will be processed without a Pastor's signature.
- 2. FACTS Online Application Workshops will again be offered. Families must sign up online for a workshop, and may view the workshop schedule at www.diometuchen.org/tuition-assistance. To register for a workshop, just follow the Workshops link. Space is limited. If school or parish staff have questions regarding the application process or require additional general training or training on how to post awards to your FACTS Tuition Management module, please contact our representative, Linda Thomas, at 732.535.0902.
- 3. If a family contacts your office because they are having difficulty signing up for an Online Application Workshop, you or the family may call Tammy Hemingway at 732.562.2452 for assistance.
- 4. If a family comes to you for help emailing or faxing documents to FGAA, and your staff are able to assist them, we would be grateful. Supporting documentation can be scanned and uploaded in .pdf format directly to their application. Documentation can also be faxed to 866.315.9264 or mailed to the address listed on the next page. Please be sure the family includes their applicant ID on all faxed or mailed correspondence.

- 5. THE DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS TO FGAA IS MARCH 31, 2017, INCLUDING SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS (the link will be inactivated on April 3). NO APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED BY MAIL.
- 6. If a family has a question you or your staff are not able to answer, they may contact FGAA directly at 866.441.4637, or the Tuition Assistance Hotline at 732.562.1990, ext. 1610. All calls to the Hotline are returned within 48 hours.
- 7. Only registered Catholic families with children (K-12) in one of our diocesan, parochial or regional schools are eligible. Pre-K students are not eligible.
- 8. Students attending the two private high schools in the Diocese (Mount Saint Mary Academy and St. Joseph High School), must seek financial assistance directly from those schools.

In order to get the word out to all families that may need to apply for an FCE Scholarship, I have asked all Principals to send a copy of the attached letter home to all parents so they are aware of the availability of this program and deadlines. This letter and its attachments are also available (English and Spanish) on our website at www.diometuchen.org/tuition-assistance. A bulletin announcement has been provided to our Communications Department and will be posted to the 'Bulletin Editors' folder on the extranet. We hope you will consider running this monthly through the end of March so we may publicize the availability of this financial aid to families new to the diocese or with children just entering Kindergarten this fall.

By signing below, the pastor of a Roman Catholic Church in the Diocese of Metuchen is confirming that the Elementary/High School applicants/s listed attend their parish, and are eligible to apply to the diocesan grant program. Eligibility requirements are listed on the back of this form and on the Diocese of Metuchen website at www.diometuchen.org/tuition-assisstance.

Forms must be signed by the Pastor and Parent/Guardian and returned to the school the student applicant plans to attend in September. Parents/Guardians are responsible for returning Pastor Signature Forms to the school by no later than March 31. If applicants in a family plan to attend different schools in the Diocese of Metuchen, then a signed Pastor Signature Form must be submitted to each school. (Eligible schools and parishes are listed on the back of this form.)

All parents/guardians must complete and pay for an FCE Scholarship application, administered by FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment (FGAA), and may do so by going to https://online.factsmgt.com/aid. The application fee is \$30, payable to FGAA.

ALL APPLICANT FAMILIES MUST:

- Complete an online application through FGAA (one application/family)
- Submit a required Pastor Signature Form to the school or schools their children will attend in September

FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment 2017-2018 SCHOOL YEAR - Application Instructions

Eligibility Requirements:

- Student must be Catholic;
- Student must be entering grades K-12 in September 2017;
- Student must be attending one of our 23 diocesan, parochial, or regional elementary schools, or Bishop Ahr or Immaculata High School; and
- Student must be registered in one of the parishes within the Diocese of Metuchen (see Required Pastor Signature form for list of eligible parishes).

Families applying for financial aid will need to complete an online application at https://online.factsmgt.com/aid. The application period is January 30, 2017—March 31, 2017. Online applications are available in Spanish and English. The application fee is \$30, and must be paid online at the time you submit your application, otherwise your application is considered incomplete and cannot be assessed. Forms of payment include debit cards, most major credit cards, or an electronic check.

Once an online application has been completed and paid for, the following information will need to be provided to FGAA to finalize the application process:

- Copies of your 2015 Federal Income Tax Return Form 1040, 1040A, or 1040EZ (as filed with the IRS) for the applicant and co-applicant, including all supporting tax schedules.
- Copies of your 2016 W-2 forms for both you and your spouse or co-applicant.
- Copies of supporting documentation for Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Workers' Compensation, and TANF.

Supporting documentation can be scanned and uploaded in .pdf format directly to your application. Documentation can also be faxed to 866.315.9264 or mailed to FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment, P.O. Box 82524, Lincoln, NE 68501-2524. Please be sure to include your applicant ID on all faxed or mailed correspondence.

FACTS Online Application Workshops are available, please see the schedule attached. Families must sign up online for a workshop and may do so at www.diometuchen.org/tuition-assistance. Space is limited. If you are not able to sign up for a workshop online, please call our Tuition Assistance Hotline at 732.562.1990, ext. 1610. If you have questions or concerns about the application process, you may contact our Tuition Assistance Hotline, or speak with a FACTS Customer Care Representative at 866.441.4637.

Every application requires the signature of the Pastor of the parish in which you are registered. No application will be reviewed without the Required Pastor Signature Form (attached), which must be signed by your Pastor and returned to the school/s your child/ren will attend in September.
