The following is the new homework policy that will be in place for all grade levels for the 2017-2018 school year. This revision will also appear in the Parent/Student Handbook that you will receive at the start of the new school year.

2017-2018 Homework Policy

Homework is a vital part of the educational process. It is a formative assessment, which allows for teachers to determine the level of proficiency each student has in a particular concept. In reality assigning a grade to a formative assessment is counter productive. The fact remains that the homework needs to be completed and quite often the notion of assigning a grade to the homework is what ensured it would be completed.

Beginning in the 2017-2018 school year, we will no longer assign a grade to the homework itself; but we will still require it to be complete. Teachers will check for homework completion and will often use an in class quiz to ensure the homework was completed. Should homework not be completed there will be ramifications that will directly affect the student.

- If homework is not completed, students will need to complete their homework during lunch and recess on the day the homework was due. We will set up locations in the cafeteria where students will sit silently, eat and complete the missing homework.
- 2. Each marking period, the teacher will allow for <u>one</u> missed homework that will not result in the above consequence.
- 3. Should a child miss five homework assignments during the course of a marking period in all classes combined, the student will receive an "X" on their report cards and will not be eligible for marking period awards, honor roll or principal list.
