## **ATTENTION BEFORE/AFTER CARE PARENTS**

*Starting on Friday, June 1<sup>st</sup> Before/After Care will need to be paid on a per day basis. For Before Care students a bill will be sent home with your child for that day and for After Care, parents when you sign your child out Mrs. Capotosto will present you with a bill. Dear St. Stans' Families:


There is so much information to share as the year comes to an end that I felt it was better to send out the information under separate cover; instead of jamming it all into a weekly letter where it might get lost.
