1. The day will be a dress down day. Costumes should not be worn to school. Students will be given **time to change after lunch.**
2. The HSA provides a pizza lunch and a snack. If your child does not like pizza please send in a lunch for them.
3. Costumes should be appropriate for a Catholic school. Please pay attention to skirt/ shorts length, how low cut a top is, and that there is nothing inappropriate written on the costume. If we deem the costume unacceptable your child will be asked to change.
4. The Halloween parade for grades Preschool through 5th grade will begin at 12:15 at the front door of the school.
5. Please make sure students in the parade are not wearing high heels, carrying accessories for the parade, do not have a mask that will obscure their vision, and the length of the costume does not cause them to trip.

Finally please be aware that due to Mass and our half day schedule there will be **NO snack sale** on Wednesday, November 1st. Please send your child to school with a snack that day.
