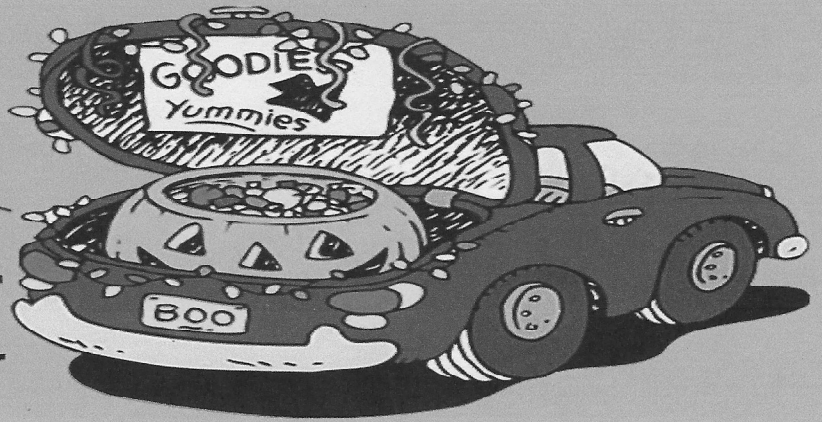

There will also be food, drinks and ice cream available for purchase as well

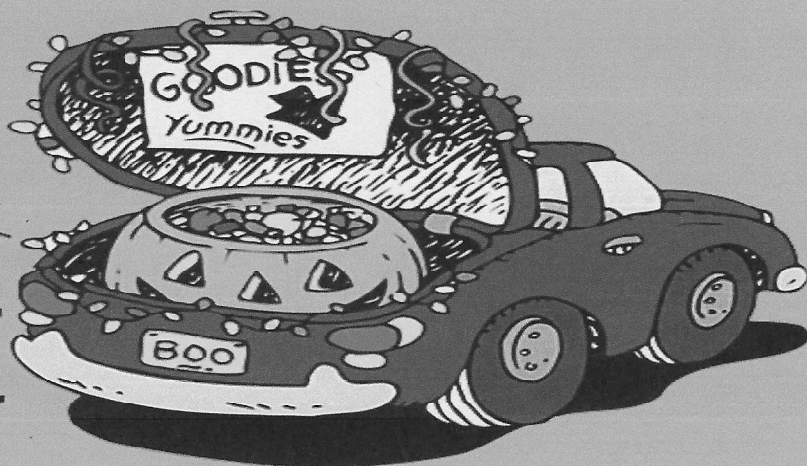

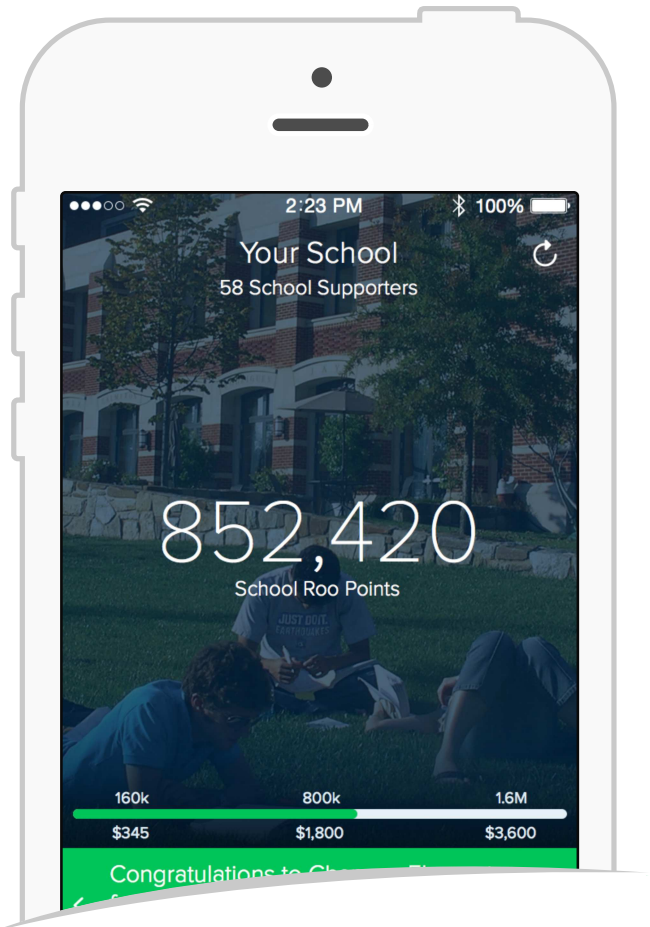

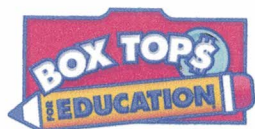
