Dear St. Stans' Families:

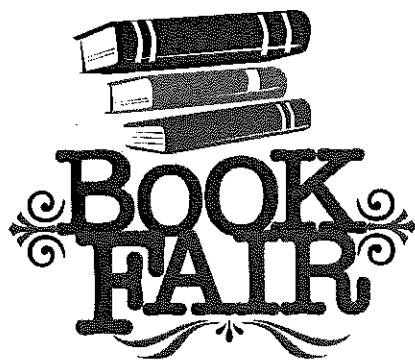

We ask you to give us a helping hand in this act of kindness. Please send the money in by January 31, 2020. Thank you for helping! God bless!

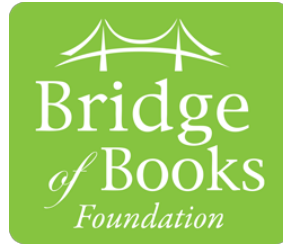
