Dear Parents,

We are asking for monetary donations to help this shelter with the medical care for the animals.

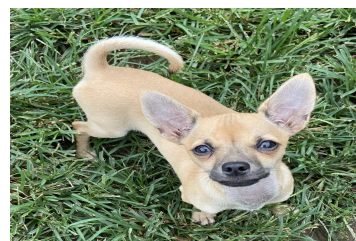
Any amount is appreciated.
