

Please send donations to Mrs. Grover by April 30th. Checks can be made out to St. Stan's School. We will be making our school donation online.




The shelter is also in need of new or gently used towels to help support our dog pals at Finding Shelter!



Re: Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord

Shortly after Easter, Cardinal Tobin asked the other four bishops of New Jersey to vote on whether or not the Solemnity of the Ascension should be transferred this year to replace the Seventh Sunday of Easter.

The bishops voted in the affirmative. As such, for 2021 in the Province of Newark, the Solemnity of the Ascension will be transferred from Thursday, May 13th to Sunday, May 16th (replacing the Seventh Sunday of Easter).

In making the declaration, the Cardinal made clear that this change is for this year only and that the matter would be evaluated by the bishops of New Jersey at their next meeting.

Please inform your parishioners of the change and make note that Thursday, Friday and Saturday of the Sixth Week of Easter are to be celebrated as such and in accord with the prescriptions of the Roman Missal and the Lectionary. Particular instructions will be forthcoming from the Office of Worship.
