

New Arrival Procedures

When we return from Easter Break on April 13, the morning arrival procedures will be a bit different in an effort to speed up the arrival process. Please review the following:

- 1. Cars will continue to line-up in the front of the building.
- Once your car is against the sidewalk, please have your child(ren) exit the car and start
 to walk up towards the front entrance. There will be teachers waiting all along the
 sidewalk to do temperature checks. Students will continue up to the front door once
 their temperature is checked. This will hopefully keep the line moving.
- 3. Preschool parents can continue to park in the lot near Jacobson Street and walk their children up to the sidewalk.
- 4. We have extended prayers until 7:50 AM this year due to the temperature taking. Going forward, if your child is not in the building by 7:50 AM, they will not be admitted until prayers are over. You can bring them to the front door as usual after that time.


