#### <u>AFTERCARE FAMILIES</u>

In preparing for the last couple weeks of school, we are asking families that utilize the aftercare program to pre-pay for the last 2 weeks of school (June 1-10). This will help ensure billing is paid for upfront. While we do know that emergencies can come up, if you are a family that doesn't utilize the aftercare program normally, you will be sent home with a bill when you pick up your child. That bill will need to be paid the next day of school.

For families that pre-pay and don't use up all of their payment, you will either be reimbursed for what you didn't use or have a credit towards the next school year.

Dear Friends,

All it takes is one person to make a difference in a rescue dog's life. Today, that person is you. Thank you for your generous, fully tax-deductible donation of \$230.00 to Finding Shelter Animal Rescue. Hope is an incredibly special case. She was sold at only four weeks of age. Two weeks later the person who bought her recognized that she was sick and had behavior issues due to being unsocialized. 
