AFTERCARE FAMILIES

In preparing for the last couple weeks left of school, we are asking families that utilize the aftercare program to pre-pay for the last few days left of aftercare in the school year (June 2 – June 11). This will help ensure billing is paid for upfront. While we do know that emergencies can come up, if you are a family that doesn't utilize the aftercare program normally, you will be sent home with a bill when you pick up your child. That bill will need to be paid the next day of school or if families would like we will have the credit card machine available in aftercare that you can pay when you receive your bill when picking up your child.

For families that pre-pay and don't use up all of their payment, you will either be reimbursed for what you didn't use (non-returning families) or have a credit towards the next school year (returning families).

The May billing invoice will go home with your child on either Monday, June 2^{nd} or Tuesday, June 3^{rd} and must be paid in full no later than Friday, June 6th.

Please send in pre-payment to the school office for June 2 - June 11 no later than Thursday, May 29th. Thank you.

Perimeter Fence Removal


